Artworks will be assessed by the expert panel of judges on the basis of: (a) understanding and knowledge of the theme; (b) artistic expression and depiction of subject matter; (c) creativity and use of color; and (d) overall impression of the art.

Please note that painting boards, drawing papers and color pencils will be provided by Bangladesh High Commission, London during the day of the competition.

The Bangladesh High Commission, London, will formally award certificates to all participants at the National Children's Day Celebration on Sunday, 17 March, 2024 immediately after the competition.
